The fourth attempt used a stronger blue color and no prill liquid, resulting in less bubbly foam but still fascinating the students as they watched it rise. Your explanation of the chemical equation and the role of each element, including the catalyst, was enlightening. The students enjoyed figuring out the variables' impact on the experiment's outcome. Your relatable example of bonds, and comparing friendships, made the concept easy to understand and memorable. This hands-on experiment truly brought science alive for them.
